

What is in the funding plans and what it is not

- Proposed are fiscally conservative construction and operating budgets
- The proposed plans:
 - No Westminster Utility Funds used to construct
 - No Westminster property taxes used to construct
 - Hospitality Taxes used to
 - Borrow (bond) for construction
 - Pay-go (pay as we go, budget some each year)
- Utilize large amounts of state/federal and outside monies (just like everyone else)
